More than 80 young people have increased their knowledge and understanding on the need to end violence against women and children in the Republic of Marshall Islands. Women United Together Marshall Islands (WUTMI RMI) recently completed an awareness session with 85 young women and men to raise awareness around the issue, and to provide information about services available that provide support to women and girls experiencing violence in RMI.
