A Women's Economic Empowerment (WEE) roundtable convened today has generated critical discussions around gender and agriculture in the Pacific.

Key presentations centered on the:

The online, quarterly WEE roundtable meetings are hosted by the Pacific Women Support Unit. This year two virtual meetings have been held, the first focussing on the socio-economic impacts of COVID-19 on women and marginalised groups.

The roundtable brings together key-stakeholders working on WEE projects across the Pacific, to contribute to the body of knowledge about what women's economic empowerment looks like in the region and how it can best be supported.

The convenings are developed to support partners keen to increase their knowledge and further improve their WEE projects to better empower women in the Pacific.
